**Facilities -- revised policy and new effective date**

In the June 2010 issue of *OfficeLink Updates*<sup>TM</sup>, we informed you of a proposed policy about multiple procedure reduction for CT scans, MRIs or ultrasounds. We will not apply this policy as planned on November 15, 2010.

**Practitioners and facilities – new claims payment policy**

With dates of service on or after **February 1, 2011**, we will allow multiple CT scans, MRIs or ultrasounds on the same day at 50 percent for the subsequent scan(s). We are basing this policy on the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services' (CMS) multiple procedure reduction policy for certain diagnostic imaging procedures.

The reduction will apply to:

- scans performed on contiguous body areas
- technical and global charges
- facility and medical claims, including independent radiology centers

The reduction will not apply to:

- professional fees billed separately
- claim lines billed with Modifier 59
